

Family Reunification



Goal of Service

To promote timely reunification for children and teens entering out-of-home placement for the first time due to well-being issues, such as but not limited to parent/child conflict, truancy, behavioral health, etc.

Eligibility Criteria

- Children and teens ages 9 to 17
- Entering out of home placement for the first time

Length of Service

- From intake until the point of reunification (or up to six months).
- Families are eligible for aftercare services for up to six weeks post reunification

Family Reunification

Description of Service

Each eligible youth will receive a FR Service Coordinator, whose main role is to promote timely connection to well-being services and break down barriers to accessing these services. Such well-being services may include but are not limited to behavioral health, housing, education, domestic violence, etc.

The FR Service Coordinator will help to navigate and advocate for resources across these informal, community-based providers. CUA workers will retain all of their current case management responsibilities, and the FR Service Coordinator will provide added support to the family (i.e., caregivers and youth) to address well-being concerns and promote timely reunification.

CUA's Role

The assigned CUA team should work with the FR Service Coordinators to identify the well-being issues that are present on the case so that they can support your team and the family in addressing these issues in a timely manner. The assigned case management team should collaborate and communicate frequently on a monthly basis to ensure the case is moving toward permanency successfully and to address any barriers in a timely manner.
